Angel of God (Elohim)

Genesis 21:17-18 (ESV)

17 And God heard the voice of the boy, and **the angel of God** called to Hagar from heaven and said to her, “What troubles you, Hagar? Fear not, for God has heard the voice of the boy where he is. 18 Up! Lift up the boy, and hold him fast with your hand, for **I will make him into a great nation.**”

Genesis 31:11-13 (ESV) *(see Genesis 28:10-22)*

11 Then **the angel of God** said to me in the dream, ‘Jacob,’ and I said, ‘Here I am!’ 12 And he said, ‘Lift up your eyes and see, all the goats that mate with the flock are striped, spotted, and mottled, for I have seen all that Laban is doing to you. 13 **I am the God of Bethel**, where you anointed a pillar and **made a vow to me**. Now arise, go out from this land and return to the land of your kindred.”

Exodus 14:19-20 (ESV)

19 Then **the angel of God** who was going before the host of Israel moved and went behind them, and the pillar of cloud moved from before them and stood behind them, 20 coming between the host of Egypt and the host of Israel. And there was the cloud and the darkness. And it lit up the night without one coming near the other all night.

Judges 6:11-24 (ESV) Judges 6:11,12, 20-22 — The angel is ref'd as "the LORD" in vs 14

11 Now the **angel of the LORD** came and sat under the terebinth at Ophrah, which belonged to Joash the Abiezrite, while his son Gideon was beating out wheat in the winepress to hide it from the Midianites. 12 And the **angel of the LORD** appeared to him and said to him, “The LORD is with you, O mighty man of valor.” 13 And Gideon said to him, “Please, my Lord, if the LORD is with us, why then has all this happened to us? And where are all his wonderful deeds that our fathers recounted to us, saying, ‘Did not the LORD bring us up from Egypt?’ But now the LORD has forsaken us and given us into the hand of Midian.” 14 And **the LORD** turned to him and said, “Go in this might of yours and save Israel from the hand of Midian; do not I send you?” 15 And he said to him, “Please, Lord, how can I save Israel? Behold, my clan is the weakest in Manasseh, and I am the least in my father’s house.” 16 And the LORD said to him, “But I will be with you, and you shall strike the Midianites as one man.” 17 And he said to him, “If now I have found favor in your eyes, then show me a sign that it is you who speak with me. 18 Please do not depart from here until I come to you and bring out my present and set it before you.” And he said, “I will stay till you return.”

19 So Gideon went into his house and prepared a young goat and unleavened cakes from an ephah of flour. The meat he put in a basket, and the broth he put in a pot, and brought them to him under the terebinth and presented them. 20 And the **angel of God** said to him, “Take the meat and the unleavened cakes, and put them on this rock, and pour the broth over them.” And he did so. 21 Then the **angel of the LORD** reached out the tip of the staff that was in his hand and touched the meat and the unleavened cakes. And fire sprang up from the rock and consumed the meat and the unleavened cakes. And the **angel of the LORD** vanished from his sight. 22 Then Gideon perceived that he was the angel of the LORD. And Gideon said, “Alas, O

Lord GOD! For now I have seen the **angel of the LORD** face to face.” 23 But the LORD said to him, “Peace be to you. Do not fear; you shall not die.” 24 Then Gideon built an altar there to the LORD and called it, The LORD Is Peace. To this day it still stands at Ophrah, which belongs to the Abiezrites.

Judges 13:6 (ESV)

6 Then the woman came and told her husband, “A man of God came to me, and his appearance was like the appearance of the **angel of God**, very awesome. I did not ask him where he was from, and he did not tell me his name,

Judges 13:9 (ESV)

9 And God listened to the voice of Manoah, and the **angel of God** came again to the woman as she sat in the field. But Manoah her husband was not with her.

2 Samuel 14:17 (ESV)

17 And your servant thought, ‘The word of my lord the king will set me at rest,’ for my lord the king is like the angel of God to discern good and evil. The LORD your God be with you!”

2 Samuel 14:20 (ESV)

20 In order to change the course of things your servant Joab did this. But my lord has wisdom like the wisdom of the angel of God to know all things that are on the earth.”

2 Samuel 19:27 (ESV)

27 He has slandered your servant to my lord the king. But my lord the king is like the angel of God; do therefore what seems good to you.
