How shall we then engage?

with Grace and Wisdom

Conduct yourselves with **wisdom** toward outsiders, making the most of the opportunity. Let your speech **always** be with **grace**, as though seasoned with salt, so that you might know how to respond to each person.

But if you have bitter jealousy and selfish ambition in your hearts, do not boast and be false to the truth. This is not the wisdom that comes down from above, but is earthly, unspiritual, demonic.

For where jealousy and selfish ambition exist, there will be disorder and every vile practice. But the wisdom from above is first pure, then peaceable, gentle, open to reason, full of mercy and good fruits.

The Black Forest trees took 40, 50, 100 years to grow... it took only the sweep of a raging fire hours to destroy them










The homes and possessions in the Black Forest represented years of work and time
