The Vision

with Grace and Wisdom and Truth


...speaking the truth in love...

why do we speak truth?

we seek their true good

+ not to "win" or for "power"



we seek their true good

+ not to "win" or for "power"

engaging our neighbors is not a prize-fight...

we seek their true good

- + not to "win" or for "power"
- nor under the guise of being a "faithful" witness

truth is not the endgame

if we see truth as the means to the end (abundant life) then it changes not only how we "receive" truth, but how we "speak" truth...

if we speak from **true agape love**, we don't speak to merely "deliver" truth, but with a sacrificial zeal that seeks another's shalom... the purpose of truth is bound up in true agape love

God's endgame is abundant life

Engaging with Truth

or you are FRIGHTENED by this:

tendency will be to not engage at all... or to "love" more than speaking truth

...let each one of you speak the **truth** with his neighbor. -Ephesians 4:25

These are the things that you shall do: Speak the **truth** to your neighbor... -Zechariah 8:16



Do you really believe God can do this?




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Truth and true agape love drive us into real relationships
