as yourself

recognize those things that help or hinder your
shalom, bearing fruit

- ♦ the desires of the sinful nature are **destructive**
- ♦ **physical** health: don't be a diseased plant; eat, sleep well; exercise
- ♦ **mental** health: deep relationships are key here
- ♦ seek **excellence** in family, vocation, ministry
- ♦ **relationships** are critical: Holy Spirit, Word; Band of Brothers; Family
- ♦ the enemy will throw all kinds of **obstacles** in your path

- ♦ pride: God opposed to the proud: Uzziah & Elijah
- ♦ all about me & fear
- ♦ isolation
- ♦ dependency
- ♦ doom, gloom and apathy
- ♦ persistent sins
- ♦ lack of vision and losing the meta-narrative

- ♦ 1.7 million **crimes** committed
- ♦ 83,000 **rapes** and **sexual assaults**
- ♦ over 3,000 **murders**
- ♦ almost 9,000 **suicides**
- ♦ almost 500,000 contracted an **STD**
- ♦ 27 billion dollars spent on **illegal drugs**
- ♦ 165,200 **babies killed** in the womb

in these ten weeks...

- ♦ over half of a million people died, most of them **without a witness** from a Christian neighbor
- ♦ many who were spiritually sick, blind, in prison, lonely, dying inside...

in a **Land of Nought**
